What is the Cellfina[™] System?

Cellfina is the only FDA-cleared minimally invasive procedure clinically proven to improve the appearance of cellulite for at least one year—the longest FDA clearance for a cellulite treatment. Performed by a qualified physician in an office setting, Cellfina combines proven and innovative technologies to clear the underlying cause of cellulite on the thighs and buttocks.

How does the Cellfina[™] System work?

The Cellfina[™] System treats the connective bands woven throughout the fat that pull down the skin, creating dimpling seen on the skin's surface. Cellfina works by precisely treating these tethered bands, encouraging them to fray and finally fully release. Similar to a rubberband under tension, once released, the treated skin bounces back to smooth itself out in as little as three days.

How soon will I see improvements?

Within just three days after treatment, patients in the FDA-approved pivotal study reported feeling very satisfied with their results. At three months, 85 percent of patients were satisfied, and after one year, 94 percent were satisfied, surpassing patient satisfaction rates versus other leading cellulite treatments.

Does Cellfina involve cutting?

Cellfina does not involve a scalpel, operating room or general anesthesia. It relies on a minimally invasive, small needle-sized device to apply light, quick and repeated pressure on the cellulite-causing bands just beneath the skin to fray and finally fully release them.

How long do results last?

Patients in the FDA-approved pivotal study showed significant improvement after just one treatment, with results lasting at least a year—the longest FDA clearance for a cellulite treatment.

Are there any side effects?

There have been no serious adverse events associated with Cellfina. The most common side effects reported by patients in the FDA-approved pivotal study were soreness and bruising. Just three days after treatment, patients rated their pain as minimal (2.7 on a scale of 0 to 10; 0=no pain, 10=extreme pain) and most (82%) felt pain only with touch or pressure to the area treated. This minimal pain improved quickly with time. Over 90% of patients had no bruising at four weeks.

How long does the procedure take?

The in-office procedure takes approximately 45 minutes, depending on the individual patient and the number of areas being treated.

Will I need to take time off?

There is limited downtime associated with Cellfina. Some patients experience initial soreness and tenderness, but these side effects resolve quickly with time.

How much does the Cellfina treatment cost?

A Cellfina treatment can range in price from \$2,000-\$5,000, depending on the number of cellulite dimples, physician practice and geographic location.
